

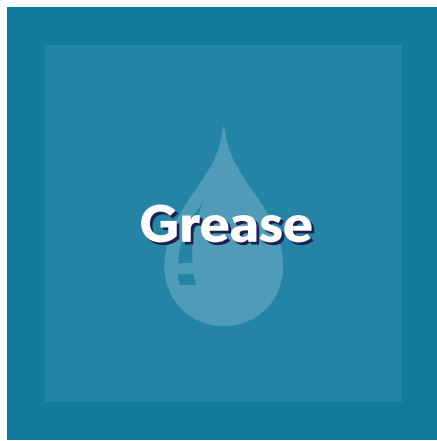
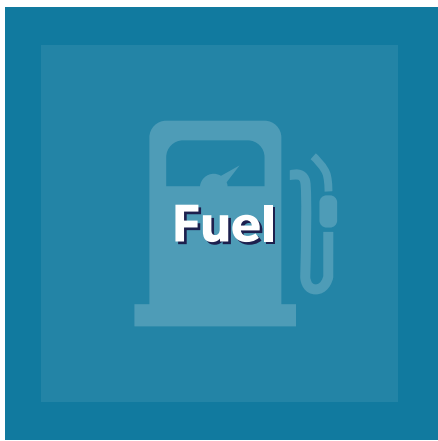


Contaminated Waste Removal

Hazardous waste is classified as being harmful to health or the environment

Does this affect my business?

Examples of Contaminants



Car Parks

Larger car parks with vehicles potentially leaking petrol, diesel and other fluids require drainage filters to safely discharge of contaminated fluids from surface water run-off.



Vehicle Depots / Hubs / Workshops

If you maintain, repair or modify vehicles (buses, trucks, vans, taxis etc) then you are responsible for the correct discharge of vehicular fluids, rather than using a regular drainage system.



Trade Premises

If your business utilises chemicals, detergents or food items, liquid waste (effluent) from these may be contaminating wastewater & should not enter the drainage system unfiltered.

Potential Risks

- Environmental damage such as erosion & flooding
- Endangering wildlife and polluting the atmosphere
- Health problems, risking disease & reproductive issues

Solutions

- Fitting three stage interceptors to drainage systems, to filter contaminated waste from entering the water system
- Relocating tasks to approved sites, designated for the discharge of contaminated waste
